To collaborate with existing paediatric networks and research organisation in the framework of the Enpr-EMA (the European Network of paediatric research at the EMEA) and other International initiatives, such as GRiP, the FP7 project aimed at promoting Global Research in Paediatrics.

To develop informative tools (tailored to industries, public agencies, researchers, health professionals, ethics committees and patients/parents organisations) in order to favor awareness on the topics of paediatric research.

To develop communication and educational tools tailored for children in order to facilitate their participation in experimental procedures.
