TEDDY Consultation

TEDDY provided its own contribution to the Horizon Europe Co-design survey launched by EC to collect inputs about the document

Orientations towards the first Strategic Plan implementing the research and innovation framework programme Horizon Europe" aimed to inform and stimulate the process to shape the European research and innovation investments in the coming years.

TEDDY provided its input in the design of the next European programme drawing attention on the paediatric issues that need stronger investments in order to deliver more benefits to the paediatric population. The paediatric topic is not specifically mentioned in the "Orientations" document and not considered as a global challenge as it is! TEDDY provided its perspective underlining the need for a paediatric centred vision to guarantee efficacious and safe drug for children.

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Public involvement

TEDDY has promoted the creation of KIDS Bari and KIDS Albania





- Both groups have been involved in meetings to train the kids on topics that belong to paediatric basic and clinical trials (biomedicine, basic research, clinical research, humanization of healthcare) and in a series of practical activities during the last year, such as:
 - Presentation at meetings and conferences to raise awareness on the importance to involve children and their family in issues related to health, medicine, research and innovation (EPTRI General Assembly March 2019 in Madrid).
 - Awareness campaigns on different topics (Rare disease day, World Kidney Day, World Asthma Day)
 - Participation in consultation activities (within the project "Consultation on civic participation in healthcare system")
